Questions/comments Pat Schmit - concerns about what we are planning for 150th St between 270th to Hwy 35

Cory Hinkel did a presentation on the upcoming school referendum - significantly lower from previous referendum tries. Would increase levy about 1.30 mil.

February minutes were presented. A motion by Greg to approve the minutes. Seconded by Larry. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given - The balance after the bills are paid is \$207,389.44. A motion by Greg to approve the treasurer's, 2nd by Larry. Motion carried.

After reviewing the bills, Greg made a motion to pay all bills for \$26,266.40. Larry 2nd it, Motion carried.

Discuss and approve roads for maintenance bids

- 1) LRIP - sand lift (12 inches compacted and spread) and gravel (6 inches of compacted class 5) 24 feet wide - 270th from hiway 35 to 150th St
- 2) pulverizing 150th St between 270th to 35 - separate by the mile
- 3) crack seal and chip seal 150th st south to Maple Hills (240th Ave) one mile
- 4) plulverize 270th Ave from 150th to 140th

Need bids by the 27th of April.
