Frederic is proud and pleased to offer park buildings and facilities for public use.

Please respect & care for facilities by following these rental guidelines:

- **No driving is allowed on park pathways.**
- No animals (other than service dogs) allowed inside park buildings

Rental Party Responsible for the following tasks at the end of reservation time:

- **Clean** kitchenette amenities; including, kitchen counter, sink, coffee maker, oven, microwave, refrigerator & floor area.
- **Place** all garbage & recycling in provided containers. Contact staff if additional bags are needed.
- **Wipe** off tables used and notify staff of any major spills.
- Remove all items **not belonging in the park shelter** by the end of event.

Frederic Parks & Recreation provides:

- Office Staff and Park Custodian to service rentals prior, during & following events.
- Sink, stove, microwave, refrigerator, counter space, trash & recycling receptacles.
- Cleaning Supplies
- Picnic Tables
- Trails, Playground, Basketball Courts, Ice Skate Rink, Gardens, Band Shell, Public Restrooms, Horseshoe Pits, Fishing Piers, Boat Launch, Sand Volleyball Courts, Softball Field, Baseball Field.

Rental & Refund Policy:

- Payment in full is required before key will be released and/or scheduled event date
- Payments are non-refundable.
- Special Use Permits require a deposit. Shelter must be inspected before deposit is returned.

Liability:

- Reservation holder is liable for all conduct of rental group, including any damage, loss or breakage as a result of conduct.

Park Shelter Rentals

Frederic has five shelters available for rent within the Village. Two of the shelters have kitchen facilities available. These shelters are available for community use & public rentals.

Shelter Name	Description	Reservation Fee
Community/Depot	Located east of the Historical Depot Museum on Gandy Dancer Trail. This shelter has electric outlets and water available. There is NO public restroom access.	\$50.00
Lakeside or Parkside w/Kitchen	Located on the West side of Coon Lake Park. These shelters have electric outlets, water available and access to restrooms. The kitchen is equipped with a sink, refrigerator, microwave and counter space.	\$100.00
Lakeside or Parkside -Shelter Only	The above shelters are also available to rent without kitchen access. They include electric outlets, water and restroom access.	\$50.00
Lower Parkside	Located in Coon Lake Park this shelter has electric outlets, water is available and there is access to restrooms.	\$50.00
East Coon Lake Park	Located on the East side of Coon Lake. This shelter has electric outlets. There is no water available and restrooms are a short walk to the other side of the lake.	\$50.00
